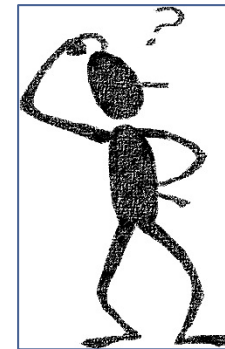

## Frequently Asked Questions

**Q.** What options do students have for High School other than Dover High?

**A.** Students may choose from the following schools:

- **Oyster River High School**
  - acceptance is based on a lottery system (no extra tuition)
- **Coe Brown Northwood Academy**
  - acceptance is based on applications (extra tuition)
- **Cocheco Arts and Technology Academy (CATA)**
  - acceptance is based on applications (no extra tuition)
- **Somersworth High School**
  - alternative to Dover High School (no extra tuition)

**Q.** What are shadow days and Information Nights?

**A.** Each of the high school options allow for students to visit the school and spend the day with a current student. This process takes place from mid September through November. Students should check in with Mrs. Murphy for details about the process for each school.

In addition, schools will offer Information Nights. These are important to attend as they help answer questions about the school and provide an opportunity to see the buildings and hear from current students. Check your email and the school website regularly for information regarding these upcoming dates.

**Q.** What is the Tuition Delta for Coe Brown Northwood Academy?

**A.** The Barrington School District pays the ORHS per pupil tuition amount for each 8<sup>th</sup> grade student. If a student attends CBNA, where the tuition is slightly higher, families become responsible for the difference between the two rates. In the past, this amount has hovered around \$2,000; however, the exact amount will not be determined until the spring.

**Q.** Can a student apply for the ORHS lottery and apply for CBNA?

**A.** Yes. Students may attempt for both the ORHS lottery and acceptance into Coe Brown. Pay attention to all deadlines!

It is anticipated that Oyster River High School will become a School of Record for the 2017/2018 school year. This means that students will be able to attend ORHS with no extra tuition cost to families. However, enrollment will be limited to 44 spots. As a result, a lottery process has been established to determine acceptance.

Students interested in attending ORHS for the 2017/18 school year must submit a written application, residency affidavit, and proof of residency to the SAU **between the dates of September 15th and March 1, 2017.**

**\*\*Individuals will receive a receipt with a corresponding number ONLY when all paperwork is complete.**

Following the March 1st deadline, at the March 7, 2017 School Board meeting, numbers will be drawn at random to fill the allotted number of ORHS spots. This will be done in two steps based on the guidelines established by the Barrington School Board.

## Coe Brown Northwood Academy

Enrollment into CBNA is based on acceptance. Students who are interested in attending Coe Brown should complete an application packet\* and return it to Mrs. Murphy **no later than January 13, 2017.**

\*Application materials will become available in early December.

There are opportunities to shadow current CBNA students from **mid September – November 22, 2016.**

### **\*\*\* Applying to Coe Brown & ORHS \*\*\***

In the event that a student applies to CBNA and submits an application for the ORHS lottery...a request can be made to extend the February 24<sup>th</sup> Deposit Deadline in order to wait for the ORHS Lottery decisions. To request an extension, contact Sally Asletine ([sasletine@coebrown.org](mailto:sasletine@coebrown.org)) or Cheri Wolf ([cwife@coebrown.org](mailto:cwolf@coebrown.org)) once CBNA admission has been accepted. If the extension is approved, the \$250 deposit to CBNA would be due March 10, 2017.
